2. Have you been concerned about anything regarding <u>(the student of concern)</u> ? If so, please explain.	
3. Are you aware of anything that has happened that has been particularly upsetting to <u>(the student of concern)</u> ?	
4. Has <u>(this student)</u> ever done something that made you feel afraid, unsafe, uncomfortable, or worried? Have you had to change anything you do because of the behavior of <u>(this student)</u> ? If so, please describe.	

5. Have you ever heard of them (the student of concern) talking about suicide, self-harm, hurting themselves, hurting others? If so, please describe.

6. Have you ever heard of (the student of concern) using or talking about weapons? Do you know if they practice or train with any weapons?

7. Have you ever heard of (the student of concern) having an interest in violent things? (This could include serial killers, school shooters, hate groups, mass attacks or other violence). If yes, ask interviewee to describe the interest.

8. Is there anyone that (the student of concern) has had an issue or negative interaction with? (If so, include a narrative of the circumstances.)

9. If (the student of concern) were to become upset, angry or frustrated, how do they typically react?

10. Are you aware of any plans that (student of concern) has to do harm to others? Have you heard of the planning for some sort of attack or incident? If so, please describe.

11. Do you have concerns that another student might help (the student of concern) carry out a plan to hurt others?

12. Has (the student of concern's) behavior changed over time? (The change could be positive or negative). Describe any changes.

13. Who are the people who know (the student of concern) the best? (Include name, relationship with student, and contact information when possible).

14. Do you know how (the student of concern) likes to spend their free time? Please explain.

15. Do you know if (the student of concern) has friends? Who do they spend time with?

16. Are you aware whether (the student of concern) is on social media? Do you know any usernames? Have they posted anything concerning? Are you willing to show us the posts/account?

17. Is there anything I can do to help kids feel safe in school?

18. Is there anyone else that we should talk to as we are trying to understand this situation?

19. Is there anything else we should know about this situation or individual?
